**RECYCLE** — Bring in your dead batteries (non-automotive), cell phones, printer cartridges and compact fluorescent bulbs to the township hall. Please put tape over the terminals on the 9volt batteries and on **ALL** lithium-ion batteries.

Remember, if you have a flag to retire, we have a container at the hall for them. The Boy Scouts will hold a ceremony to dispose of them.

**WALKING TRAIL** — The first phase of the walking trail in complete! It's been finished to a gravel surface this year. We're hoping to have it paved in the next couple of years. We are providing this great project with monies received from the excise money received from cannabis sales in our township.

**PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT** — We've placed the order for some new playground equipment! It won't arrive until late this summer and will be a great addition to the park. We'll get adding more as

we get funds allocated for it. The money for this equipment was provided by the ARPA Funds from the Federal Government.

**STATION 5 FIRE DEPARTMENT** — Our fire department not only provides fire protection services but also medical first response, vehicle extrication, search and rescue, ice & water rescue, hazardous materials management (operational level), and fire prevention services. Calls for service continue to increase and in 2022 we responded 550 times to either fire or medical first response calls. With this continued increase comes a continued demand for emergency response staff in which our paid, on-call crew members are on-call 24/7 for 365 days a year. We look forward to growing as a department in providing these essential services for our community.

**NEW FIRE/MEDICAL FIRST RESPONDER STATION & TOWNSHIP OFFICES PROJECT** — We have made much progress this year and are very close to finalizing the design and planning for the new building. Department heads and township officials have been working with the design firm and construction management team to produce the best and most effective building possible and within the confines of the budget. Stay tuned and you should finally see some activity at the new build site before the end of this year. **HEADLEE ROLLBACK** — Headlee was voted in back in 1982. At that time, Benzonia Township was operating on 1.21 mills and since that time the millage has rolled back to 0.7946 mills. This is happening with every unit of government in Benzie County. This directly impacts the income we receive from taxes which impacts projects we can do like paving roads, park, cemetery upgrades and maintenance, etc. The only way we can get an override is to put it before the voters at the county level. You can expect to see more about this in the near future.
