Supervisor Barnard brought up Higgins Road brining operation. Motion: Burns made a motion to contract with Bob Kerby to brine Higgins Road in coordination with BCRC. Sheila Priest seconded. After a roll call vote, and all voting AYE, motion carried.

A new defibrillator was purchased by the Fire Department to replace the old one.

The clerk said that all election officials will be certified this week and she will have a list for the Board as well as both parties by close of business on Thursday. This is for the Primary Election, 8/4/20.
